Even though we give out many one-time 4-year \$1500 university/college scholarships to high school seniors, we also would like it if you would encourage students that wish to go to a technical college in the trades.

Technical Colleges are an important resource for students and qualify for WSTF Scholarship Awards.

For example, a Wisconsin Technical College offers 115 programs, 38 Certificates and 13 Apprenticeships.

This year the Foundation (WSTF) will award <u>a minimum of</u> twenty-four (24) scholarships to high school seniors graduating in 2024. Each scholarship will be a one-time award of \$1,500. Two-year technical college applicants are also eligible for the one-time award of \$1,500. In addition, the Foundation will also award up to five (5) scholarships to high school seniors graduating in 2024 that will be attending a two-year technical college. These two-year technical college scholarships will be a one-time award of \$1,000. Students wanting to attend a Technical College are encouraged to apply for a scholarship.
